keep stuff, and get help from Cortana, the voice activated assistant. Thu 11/8 OR Fri 12/7 1-2pm

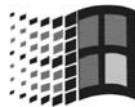
MICROSOFT One Note – 1 session, 2 hours

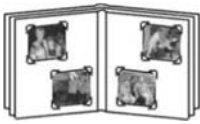

Learn how to add friends, unfriend and block intruders. Find out how to upload content, links and photos. Create or join existing Facebook groups. Bring your Facebook log-in credentials to class. INTRO TO GENEALOGY: 2 sessions, 2

hours each - This class will help you as you begin to build a family tree. It will introduce you to the charts and conventions that Genealogists use to record family data. Ancestral



Charts will be provided. You will begin with yourself and what you know and work backwards. Research resources and techniques will be discussed, as will the types of Genealogical documents that are available

online. The most Frequently Asked Questions posed to Genealogists in recent years are about DNA testing. Yes, there will be time for answer your questions about the kinds of DNA, the companies that test, and what DNA test results reveal. Tue 9/25 & 10/2 1-3pm
